Post Moderation

Toi Mai Workforce Development Council is now the standard setting body for Technology.

We sent out a communication in January of this year, outlining the external moderation plan and what our expectations would be regarding the submission of assessment samples.

We want to ensure that all assessment against our unit standards is of a consistent quality and meets the requirements of the standard and to meet consent and moderation requirements (CMR).

To achieve this we require that all assessment material is pre-assessment moderated by either a TITO or ourselves.

When we send out a request for assessment samples for post moderation, we advise that you are required to confirm and provide evidence that assessment material had been pre-moderated and approved for use.

Pre-Moderation

If you are using assessment material from a TITO, this will already have been pre-moderated and **does not** require approval from Toi Mai.

If you use assessment material from an external provider/school or you develop your own material, it is your responsibility to ensure that the material has been pre-moderated and approved by a TITO previously, or this will be submitted to Toi Mai for approval. Please note there is no charge for Toi Mai pre-moderation.

If your organisation is currently using assessment material from the **computing domain** that has **not** been pre-moderated and approved for use by a TITO: please continue to use the material to assess and report for the remainder of 2022.

Toi Mai expects that from 1 January 2023, material used in assessment will be pre-moderated: either previously from a TITO, or through Toi Mai.

The proviso that current non premoderated assessment material can be used up until 31 December 2022, is taking into consideration that pre-moderation requirements from NZQA and TITOs differed from Toi Mai's intent and requirement for pre-moderation, and the recent review of computing unit standards. The approved changes will be available on the NZQA framework over the next few weeks and the NZQA approved report will be uploaded to the Toi Mai website as soon as it's available, here: [Communications - Toi Mai](#)

Providers and schools will have time to transition from using the current Computing unit standards to those updated in the review but we recommend transition to the new standards and versions if assessment material requires pre-moderation.

2023 pre-moderation

- The turnaround for pre-moderation is 20 working days.
- Remember: take into account NZQA changes and transition timeframes when developing assessment material for pre-moderation.
