- Methods and techniques for ensuring client comfort and safety throughout the service.
- Awareness of safe ergonomic posture through the course of a service to avoid personal injury.
- Cleaning and/or sanitising tools, equipment, and work areas to a standard that is consistent with relevant legislation and codes of practice.
- Maintaining personal presentation and hygiene to a professional standard.
- Observing ethical and other appropriate standards as required by legislation and codes of practice.
